



The Pro~Kix Official Policies

(All policies are designed to improve player and spectator's enjoyment.)

General Spectator and Player Consideration

- No Gum is allowed in the sports arena
- As with all recreation activities, indoor soccer has inherent risks associated with participation. Parents/ guardians of youth players, youth and adult players accept such risks as a result of their participation in our facility. All participants must complete a proper Consent Form to participate.
- Due to the nature of indoor soccer, balls may exit the field of play. Pro~Kix is not responsible for injuries to spectators, coaches and players while attending an activity of Pro~Kix.
- Pro~Kix is not responsible for lost or stolen items that are left unattended.
- Please show courtesy and respect to other spectators, players, and coaches by **ACTING WITH GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP**. This includes refraining from inappropriate or abusive language, dissent (verbally or through action) to spectator player, coach, official, or employee. Anyone taking such inappropriate action may be required to leave the sports arena immediately.
- Parents are responsible for supervising their children while inside the facility! Pro~Kix will not be held liable if your child gets hurt while left unattended. Also, all damages that occur to Pro~Kix property due to lack of supervision will be the responsibility of the parent/ guardian.
- Absolutely no food or beverage is allowed on the field. Only lid contain beverages are allowed in the spectator area.
- Anyone found guilty of willfully damaging Pro~Kix property will be banned from the Pro~Kix sports arena and legal action will follow.

Team Information

- All teams and individual players, as well as associated parents or guardians, are required to play under the rules and policies of Pro~Kix. It is the

responsibility of the team manager to inform the players and parents of this policy.

- All youth Parents or adult players must sign and have on file the required player consent form in order to play.
- All rosters are kept at the registration office and must be filled out completely prior to the first game.
- Each and every player and coach must sign the roster in order to play or coach for that team. Players are only permitted to play on one team in a division in any given session/ tournament. Players are bound to play with that team for the duration of the session/ tournament.
- All adult players MUST BE 18 years of age and out of high school.
- All players MUST meet the age and/ or gender criteria for the league/ tournament to be eligible to play.
- A parent coach/ manager must be present at ALL youth and high school games.
- Proof of age must be available upon request if there is dispute about a participant's age. Proof shall be in the form of a birth certificate, driver's license or other suitable record approved by Pro~Kix. The team manager/coach is responsible for playing with eligible players only. Teams/managers/players not complying with this procedure will assume guilt and forfeit game. **ANY TEAM PLAYING WITH ILLEGALLY AGE PLAYERS MAY FACE REMOVAL FROM THE SESSION OR TOURNAMENT WITHOUT REFUND!**
- Post Game Team Gatherings must be done in the spectator areas (off of the field).

Scheduling

- Teams/ Players registering for league/ tournament play must be prepared to play during any of the days and times indicated in the league/ tournament brochures etc. Alternate games days may be required and assigned without notice. Pro~Kix is not responsible for team scheduling conflicts or forfeited games.
- Games may ONLY be rescheduled with permission of Pro~Kix management. Due to loss of field time and staffing cost associated with rescheduling games, an associated fee will be pre-paid for any game rescheduled. It is the responsibility of the teams to get approval and coordinate a different game time with their opponent. Both team managers/ coaches must indicate their approval to Pro~Kix management. Communication by all team managers must be completed at least 1 week prior to any changes.
- Schedules are subject to change without approval. League alignments may vary from session to session in an attempt to balance leagues. Days and Times may vary from session to session.

- Each session length will vary due to holidays and tournaments. Each team is guaranteed seven games. The number of teams may allow for more games in a session. However, this will also vary from division to division.
- Many variables go into aligning divisions. Your skill level information, although important, does not guarantee the division that your team is placed into. Every effort will be made to equalize competition skill levels in our leagues. However, Pro~Kix does not guarantee quality of play!
